Where and how do I check in my child for Adventure Week?

- Upon arrival, check-in at one of the stations in the Concourse.
 - Self-check-in begins at 8:30 am.
 - Children will receive two tags during check-in. One to wear and the other to give to their Group Leader.
- Stay with your child/children each morning until the Auditorium doors open at 8:45 am.
- Each Community Group will have a directional sign to designated seating areas by Tribe (grade) and Group number.

Where can I pick up my child's T-shirt and Parent Packet with the Family Security Code Cards?

- Sunday, June 8, 8:30 am–12:30 pm in the Balcony Room.
- Monday, June 9, 8–9 am at the Information desk.

What should my child wear during Adventure Week?

We'll be very active, so we ask that kids wear appropriate attire, such as:

- A T-shirt and shorts. No bathing suits, please. Lighter-colored clothing is recommended.
- Comfortable clothes that can get dirty.
- Comfortable closed-toe shoes (preferably tennis shoes).
- Comfortable shorts that are fingertip length or longer. Please make sure clothing is modest, covering both the chest and stomach.
- We will be having themed days. Kids can dress up in comfortable and appropriate themed attire.
Monday- Party Animals. Tuesday- Luau. Wednesday- Tribe Spirit Day. Thursday- Neon.

Where and how do I pick up my children?

- Early pick-ups must be before Noon.
- Please return at 12:30 pm to the designated pick-up location(s) for your child(ren). (See the check-out map in the Parent Packet). You'll be asked to show your Family Security Code Card or text to the dismissal volunteer.
- If you have children in multiple grades, you must go to each child's tribe to pick them up individually. This will be the same area where you drop them off in the morning.
- Each family will receive one hardcopy card and a text message with the Family Security Code. The code on the card and in your text will be the same code printed on your child's tag during check-in.
- This Family Security Code will be used to pick up all your children from K5-Grade 5 for the entire event.
- If you lose your Family Security Code, please visit the Information Desk (located in the Concourse) to receive a text of the code. Be prepared to show a picture ID.
- If someone other than yourself is picking up your child, ensure they have the Family Security Code Card or text to show at pick-up.

What do I do if my child has allergies or needs to take medication?

When you registered your child, you should have had a chance to list your child's allergies.

- Make sure your child's allergy alert is listed on their nametag at check-in.
- You are responsible for making the Community Group Leader aware of your child's allergies.

If your child has medication:

- A Medication Authorization Form and letter will be in your Parent Packet so you can prepare your child's medication in advance.
- You can leave your child's medicine at the Medication Drop-off Station in the Concourse on Monday morning. Then, please pick it up on Thursday by 12:30 pm.

What other important information do I need to know?

- A light snack is provided for children.
- Each child will receive a water bottle on Monday to carry throughout the week.
- Eat a hearty breakfast.
- Lunch will not be served.
