#### Conversation Starter

Describe a time you felt alone.

#### Opening in Prayer

Spend a few minutes in silence. Ask God to help you hear His voice as you read and study and discuss this week's teaching with others.

#### Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read [Exodus 5:22-6:9](#).

1. How is God working in this part of the Exodus story? What is He doing?
2. Have you ever felt too broken or unqualified to take on a role in the church? If so, how did you respond when you felt that way?
3. What does it mean to walk by faith? For further insight see [Joshua 1:1-9](#) and [James 2:14-16](#).
4. Describe what it looks like to have a close relationship with God? How would your life be different if you had a closer relationship with Him?
5. What specific things could you do this week to pursue a deeper relationship with God? Pause for a few minutes and ask God to put some clear ideas in your mind.
6. God seemed to speak fairly clearly to Moses. React to that. How does that strike you? Do you think God speaks that clearly to people now?

7. How does obedience to God cultivate intimacy with God?
8. How did Moses come to know God by experience? There are some great examples in [Exodus 33:7-23](#).
9. How does Moses' story help you understand your own relationship with God?
10. What's one of the most significant Scriptures or ideas from this week's teaching?
