

Family Talk – *God's Letter to the Compromising*

READ TOGETHER

Revelation 2:12–17

1. What does it look like to remain loyal to Jesus?
2. Verse 16 calls the hearers to repentance. What does it mean to repent? Is there anything you regret and would like forgiveness for doing or thinking?
3. In the letters to the churches in Revelation, Jesus instructs us, as part of the church, to listen to the Spirit. How are you intentional in listening for what God wants to share with you?

LIVE IT

The letter to the church in Pergamum refers to evil people having a prominent place of influence. These evil people led many astray with incorrect teaching. Just as Jesus instructed the church to separate themselves from these types of people, we also need to be aware of who we allow to influence our lives.

Whose words impact your choices and how you live your life? If you're compromising your morals and integrity, allowing certain people to cause you to think, do, listen or look at things that don't honor Christ, maybe you should think about changing friends. Consider the importance of your relationships because they play a crucial role in your pursuit of relationship with Jesus.
