READ TOGETHER

Exodus 3:1-10

1. God spoke to Moses from a burning bush. What are some other ways God spoke to people in the Bible?
2. Why did God reach out to Moses?
3. What are some ways God may be speaking to you?

LIVE IT

When God spoke to Moses, He had a specific job for him to do. God didn't need Moses' help since He's the omnipotent God. He could have easily spoken a word and rescued His people. Instead, God chose to use Moses to carry out His will. But He had to communicate it to Moses first, and He does the same for us.
