Conversation Starter

Describe a time when you got lost as a child.

Opening in Prayer

The Spirit alone gives eternal life. Human effort accomplishes nothing. And the very words I have spoken to you are spirit and life. **John 6:63 (NLT)**

Spend a few minutes in prayer asking God to reveal His words to you.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Jesus spoke to His disciples shortly before the time He was to be crucified, and revealed more insight on who He claimed to be.

Read John 14:1-3.

1. Why was Jesus speaking words of comfort to His disciples (See John 13:33)?
2. What is reassuring about Jesus' words in verses 1-3?

Read John 14:4-7.

3. If you had been with the disciples, how would you have responded to Jesus' statement in verse 4?
4. What is the way to be in relationship with God the Father?
5. How would you respond to someone who says there are many ways to God (Acts 4:12, 1 Timothy 2:5-6, 1 John 5:12)?
6. How have you experienced Jesus as the Way?

Read John 14:8-11.

7. How would you summarize what Jesus is saying about Himself?
8. What convinces you that Jesus is the Truth?
9. What distinct characteristics of the life that Jesus offers have you experienced?
10. What work have you seen Jesus do in your, or someone else's, life? What would you like to ask Him to do?

John 6:63 indicates there is life in the words of Jesus. Read slowly His words in John 14:1-11, asking the Spirit to reveal what Jesus wants you specifically to know. Choose one phrase that Jesus said, and think about it each day this week.
