

Family Talk – *Peril of Faith: Rahab*

READ TOGETHER

Joshua 2:1–21

1. How did Rahab help the Israelite scouts?
2. Why do you think Rahab was willing to assist the scouts?
3. When you see someone willing to help others at risk to themselves, how does that make you feel?

LIVE IT

Rahab didn't have the best reputation, but she was able to be used in significant ways by God. Rahab heard about the power of God and acknowledged that He was working on behalf of His people. Because of the location of her home on the city wall, Rahab was in a unique position to be able to help the Israelite scouts. She is one of only two women mentioned in the faith hall of fame in Hebrews 11, and she's in the lineage of Jesus. What an honor!

How has God uniquely positioned you to advance the Kingdom? What relationships and situations might you leverage for the glory of God? Ask the Holy Spirit to give you an awareness of how He may use you and then be willing to take action.

LEAN ON GOD

Dear God,
